## **POSITION OVERVIEW**

Planned Parenthood Toronto is the co-lead of a Community Alliance with the Factor Inwentash Faculty of Social Work at the University of Toronto on the five year project "AFFIRM", which will deliver affirmative coping skills programs to prevent HIV and Hepatitis C among LGBTQ youth. The Coordinator, AFFIRM Project will be responsible for coordinating all aspects of project logistics and implementation, with a focus on delivering the AFFIRM intervention in partnership with other project staff and community organizations.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Liaise with agencies where the AFFIRM intervention will be offered
- Conduct promotion and outreach activities for AFFIRM groups
- Recruit LGBTQ youth participants for AFFIRM group sessions
- Schedule and co-facilitate AFFIRM group sessions as lead facilitator
- Support the evaluation of the AFFIRM program
- Establish implementation and intervention procedures for AFFIRM
- Provide a vital link between AFFIRM community partner sites and the Community Alliance
- Participate in project meetings and attend trainings
- Recruit, facilitate and provide support to a volunteer Youth Advisory Board which will advise on the project
- Ensure the project is meeting its outcomes under the direction of the Director of Community Programming and Research
- Track spending and maintain appropriate records
- Maintain statistics and prepare narrative and statistical reports as directed

- Master's degree in social work, psychology, education or a related field; or equivalent relevant experience
- Minimum 3 to 5 years' experience in a community setting
- Experience and commitment to working with LGBTQ youth from diverse communities from an anti-oppression perspective
- Strong experience with program coordination

- Sound knowledge of issues affecting LGBTQ youth and their sexual health
- Knowledge of and experience with effective HIV and/or Hepatitis C program delivery
- Training and experience utilizing cognitive behavioural therapy
- Experience delivering group interventions
- Considerable work experience and capacity to collaborate with community partners at multiple levels
- Excellent interpersonal and intercultural skills
- Demonstrated commitment to equity goals and principles, to sexual and reproductive rights, to being youth positive, LGBTQ positive and sex positive and to being inclusive of diverse sexual and gender identities.

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Strong administrative and organizational skills
- Proficiency and experience working in a computerized environment
- Commitment to working cooperatively in a community-based setting as part of an interdisciplinary team of staff, students and volunteers
