

Hart House is approximately a 10 minute walk from FIFSW.

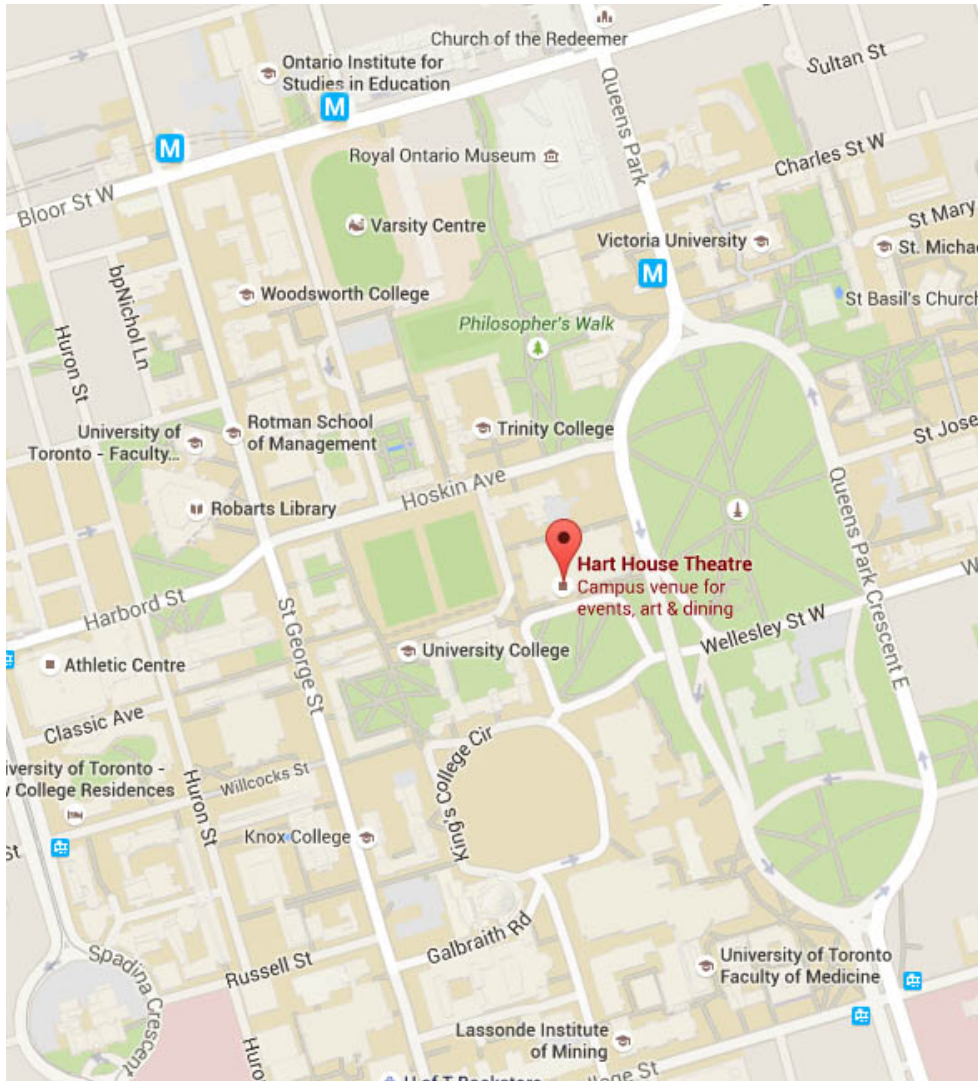
