The Factor-Inwentash Faculty of Social Work (FIFSW) provides a minimum funding commitment of \$17,500 for PhD students after paying off tuition and fees. This funding commitment is valid for up to five years, and is a combination of:

- The University of Toronto Fellowship (UTF)
- Research & Teaching Assistantships (Work)
- Other external funding sources


To be eligible for this funding commitment, students are required to:

- Be engaged in full-time studies for the academic year
- Complete program requirements in a timely manner
- · Remain in good academic standing

Top-Up Funding

Students who hold an Ontario Graduate Scholarship (OGS) and regular SSHRC awards will receive top-up funding according to their progress in the PhD program. Top-up funding is available to students up to Year 5.

- Top-up of **\$5,000** will be provided to students who have <u>not</u> received their candidacy by January 31, 2018.
- Top-up of \$6,500 will be provided to students who have received their candidacy by January 31, 2018.
- Students who hold a higher valued major external award, such as CGS-SSHRC, CIHR doctoral awards and the Vanier, are <u>not eligible</u> to receive topup funding.
