# 2017 – 2018

The Factor-Inwentash Faculty of Social Work (FIFSW) provides a minimum funding commitment of **\$17,500** for PhD students **after paying off tuition and fees**. This funding commitment is **valid for up to five years**, and is a combination of:

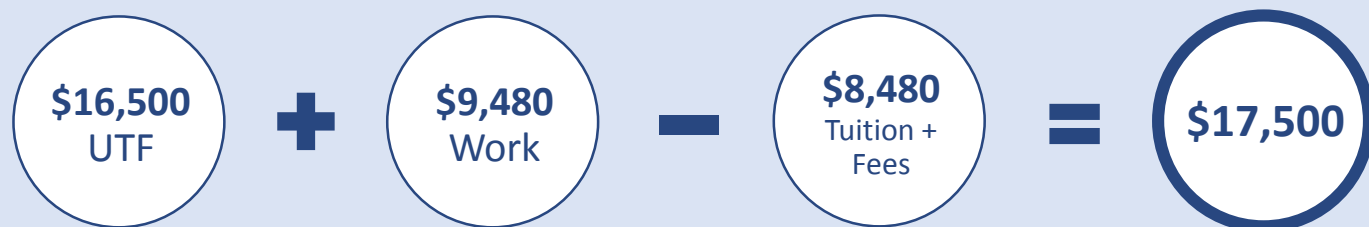
- The University of Toronto Fellowship (UTF)
- Research & Teaching Assistantships (Work)
- Other external funding sources

**To be eligible for this funding commitment, students are required to:**

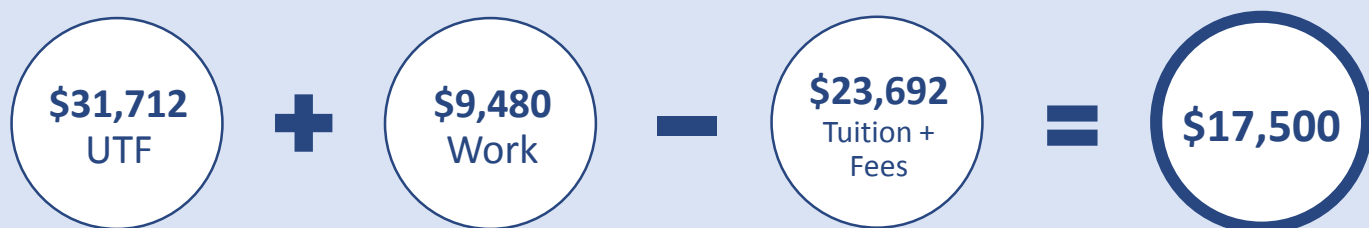
- Be engaged in full-time studies for the academic year
- Complete program requirements in a timely manner
- Remain in good academic standing

**DOMESTIC STUDENTS** | *who do not hold a major external award*

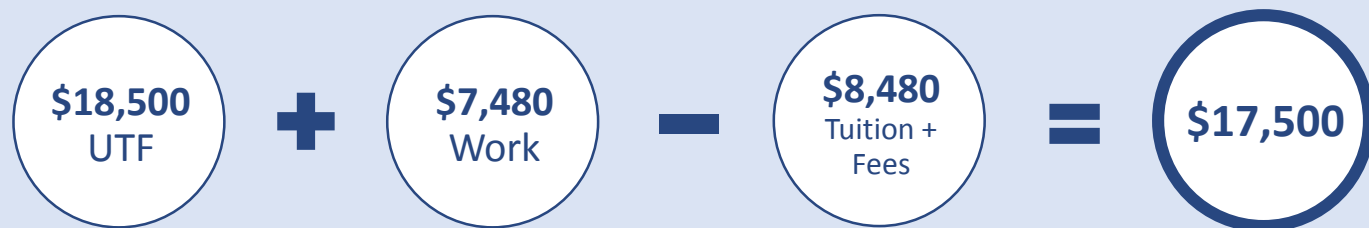


**INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS** | *who do not hold a major external award*

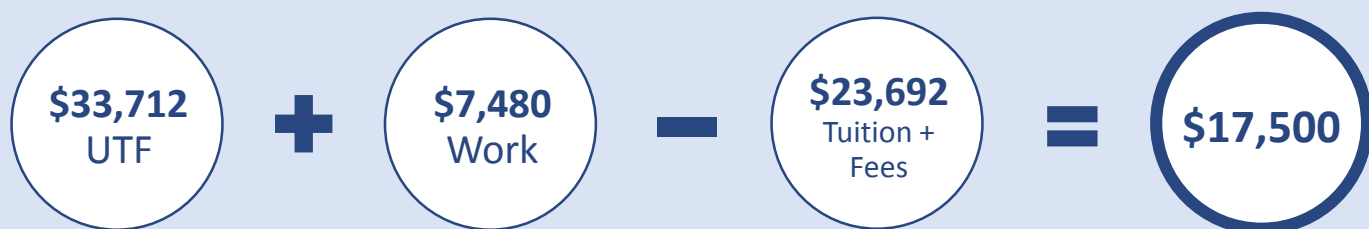


# CANDIDACY to PhD YEAR 5

## Top-Up Funding

Students who hold an Ontario Graduate Scholarship (OGS) and regular SSHRC awards will receive top-up funding according to their progress in the PhD program. Top-up funding is **available to students up to Year 5**.

- Top-up of **\$5,000** will be provided to students who have not received their candidacy by January 31, 2018.
- Top-up of **\$6,500** will be provided to students who have received their candidacy by January 31, 2018.
- Students who hold a higher valued major external award, such as CGS-SSHRC, CIHR doctoral awards and the Vanier, are not eligible to receive top-up funding.
