We wanted to ensure this information is shared so students do not miss out on these rich learning opportunities.

WHAT ARE COMPETITIVE AND OFF-PAS PRACTICUMS?

These are practicum opportunities posted on the website (not the PAS) that have a unique application process and/or requirements.

Most require students to send a cover letter and resume to the practicum site before a specific deadline. Each site has its own application process. Most of these sites will only follow-up with students who are accepted for interviews.

Please note, there is no obligation or requirement for students to participate in this process. If you are interested in the opportunities posted, you are welcome to apply

Students are encouraged to check out the practicum opportunities on the website regularly as new opportunities continue to be added.

COMPETITIONS- WHAT ARE THEY?

Competitive practicums are opportunities where FIFSW students are applying for practicums that are also open to students from other academic programs. FIFSW students compete with other students for a limited number of spots.

There are also internal competitions. These are opportunities where FIFSW students compete internally for a practicum. Field Instructors will review applications and decide which candidates to interview.

PRACTICUMS SECURED FOR BIPOC,LGBTQ2S, GENDER-DIVERSE STUDENTS

Some field instructors have expressed a preference for students in equity deserving groups; BIPOC, LGBTQ2S and/or Gender-Diverse students. These preferences are clearly indicated in bold letters on the FIFSW website.

There may also be other preferences or requirements specified by field instructors, such as evening attendance, language requests, access to a car, drivers license etc...

Please make sure that you meet the requirements before submitting an application.

OUTSIDE OF THE GTA OPPORTUNITIES

Practicum opportunities located outside of the GTA are also posted on the website. The location of the practicum is in **the title**.

If you are interested in a practicum outside of the GTA that is not on our website, please email me, <u>miri.ben.dat@utoronto.ca</u>.

The Practicum Office cannot guarantee that all requests for opportunities outside of the GTA will be met. However, we try our best to accommodate student requests.

WHO SHOULD APPLY FOR AN OFF-PAS PRACTICUM?

Anyone interested in one of the available opportunities on the website

Anyone keen to begin the practicum matching process soon (you can start today!)

Anyone who meets the specific practicum requirements indicated on the website

Anyone interested in an out of town practicum

WHAT IF I **APPLY FOR AN OFF-PAS** PRACTICUM AND AM **SUCCESSFUL?**

If you apply and are offered a practicum and accept the offer- congratulations- you are matched! You will not be a part of the PAS matching process

WHAT IF I **APPLY AND DO** NOT GET A PRACTICUM OR **DECIDE NOT TO** ACCEPT A PRACTICUM **OFFER?**

If you do not get a practicum offer or apply and decide that it is not a good fit, you will be included in the PAS matching process.

We ask that as a courtesy to the practicum site, students respond to the practicum offer within 48 hours.

WHAT IF I **APPLIED- BUT HAVE NOT YET HEARD BACK FROM AN OFF-PAS SITE AND THE PAS** MATCHING **PROCESS IS BEGINNING?**

We are hoping that the **early matching process** will be completed before the PAS opens. If, however, you have interviewed for an Off-PAS practicum and have not yet heard back, you **can be** a part of the PAS matching process.

If you are waiting for a response from an Off-PAS site, please reach out to me and I will follow-up with the site.
