Practicum Opportunity 1:

Intake and Assessment Teams:

Intake and Assessment Team works with families to conduct initial investigations to address child protection concerns. As student employee would be assisting with, and as they grow comfortable, leading in conducting investigations, attending virtual court, processing collaterals, attending internal and external meetings, making referrals, and researching appropriate resources for families.

The Diversity, Equity and Inclusion team works with members within the organization and community to address issues of discrimination and equitable services for families. The student employee will sit in and support with various DEI consults, reviewing of policies to ensure DEI concepts are incorporated, creating and delivering relevant DEI training and collaborating with members from the community. There will also be a specific focus on the Indigenous community and the work that is being done with respects to Truth and Reconciliation and the 9 Indigenous commitments to the sector.
