#### Please provide a description of the practicum site and student activities:

The Royal is one of Canada's foremost mental health care and academic health science centres. The Royal's goal is to get more people living with mental illness into recovery faster. The Royal combines the delivery of specialized mental health care, advocacy, research and education to transform the lives of people with complex and treatment resistant mental illness

At the Royal, students will be involved in:
