The Cardiac and Vascular program at Hamilton Health Sciences provides advanced care for patients from across Central South Ontario. We specialize in the diagnosis, treatment and care of people with conditions relating to the heart and vessels of the body. We are the designated cardiac centre in our region, and we're also home to one of Ontario's largest heart surgery centres.

Cardiology & Vascular Surgery Unit (4 West)

The Cardiology and Vascular Surgery Inpatient Unit (4 West) cares for patients who require special care for heart-related issues or who are waiting for/have had vascular surgery.

Our team cares for patients who have or are waiting for:

- heart failure
- heart rhythm problems
- a heart attack
- angiography or angioplasty
- coronary bypass surgery
- a heart infection or fluid around the heart
- a cardiac procedure or test
- a pacemaker insertion
- an ICD (implantable cardioverter defibrillator) insertion
- vascular stenting
- femoral- popliteal bypass
- aortic aneurysm repairs

On 4 West, there is also a "step-down" unit for patients who need closer monitoring and care by our nursing team.

Coronary Care Unit

The Coronary Care Unit (CCU) at Hamilton General Hospital cares for patients with heart issues who require intensive care.

- mechanical ventilation
- specialized cardiology procedures
- intra aortic balloon pump support
