We are a family health team based in Scarborough. We work with clients from different cultures, religions, sexual orientation and financial backgrounds. We offer individual and group therapy. The main challenges that our clients present with are anxiety, depression, stress, interpersonal difficulties, personality disorders, and trauma. **I am off on Thursdays so they would be doing independent work that day (trainings, preparing for groups). Also since I have a long day on Wednesdays, Thursday would be a shortened day. This would also be a day that they would possibly co-facilitate workshops with one of our nurses.

Practicum Requirements:

- N95 Respirator/Mask Fitting
- Comfort working with the population being served
- Evening attendance
- Students in this placement will need to have a caseload of 5 clients by Mar. They will be co-facilitating 2 groups during the course of their placement and be co-facilitating different workshops. The expectation is that by week 5 they have started to build their caseload. They will also be attending a workshop around motivational interviewing during the first three months of their placement if they are not familiar with that modality. The hours will be 9 to 8:30pm on Wed when groups are being run (for a total 9 hours). Thursdays will be 5 hours (hours will be based what the student wants unless there are workshops). Friday 9 to 5.
