This would be a placement at one of our Hillel campus locations (most likely U of T, but options for TMU, McMaster, Guelph, Western, or Queens as well). Hillel is a home away from home for Jewish students, where they are able to access support, advocacy (related to increased antisemitism on campus), and participation in Jewish cultural and also religious activities. Role would be a combination of working with students in wellness workshop planning and delivery and seeing students in-person or virtually for mental health short-termed counselling, as well as supporting the rest of the campus team in the overall operation of the Hillel space, in both front-line and administrative activities.
