Practicum Description

<u>Critical Care Unit (Oshawa site and Ajax/Pickering)</u>: Acute-care Critical Care Unit in Oshawa; 38-bed unit. In Ajax- 16 beds. Crisis intervention, emotional support, end-of-life decision making, supportive counselling services provided to patients and their families. Conduct peer support for team members, and CODE responses.

Practicum Requirements

- Immunizations per PHA Guidelines
- N95 Respirator/Mask Fitting
- Covid Vaccinations
- Influenza Vaccination (Flu shot)
- Police Reference/Vulnerable Sector Check
- Comfort working with the population being served
- Comprehensive report writing and documentation
- Other requirements: Covid Vaccinations -Laptop may be required. Preference for students with experience with palliative care, and end of life.

This practicum is fully in-person and offers direct-practice.
