Practicum Description

Bellwood Health Services, situated in Toronto's Eglinton and Laird district, a distinguished treatment facility that integrates both private and public resources. This practicum is tailored for students pursuing an interest in mental health and addiction.

Learning experiences will encompass observation, facilitation, shadowing of support staff, and involvement in project-based tasks. Moreover, students will have opportunities for social connection within the Bellwood community and group settings, fostering supportive interactions outside of clinical contexts. Although direct one-on-one therapy sessions are not available to students, they will have the chance to refine their social work skills and engage in supportive dialogues with clients, fostering both personal and professional development. By the end of their placements, students will acquire knowledge in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), understanding of psycho-educational groups, and insights into prevalent issues faced by individuals struggling with addiction, including but not limited to boundaries, people-pleasing, and communication challenges. Shadowing opportunities will extend across various groups, providing a holistic learning experience.

Students will witness the assessment process firsthand and document their observations, integral to their learning journey. Furthermore, they will have the chance to explore different facets of the program, including admissions and nursing departments, to gain a comprehensive understanding of Bellwood Health Services.
